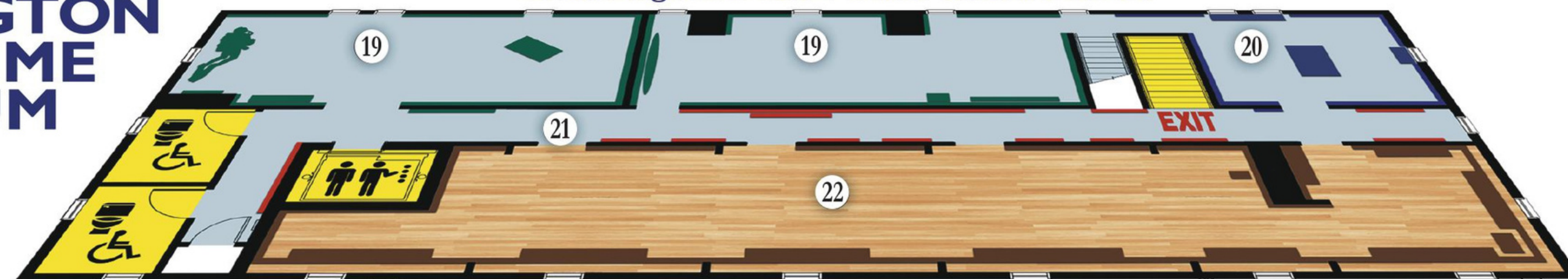


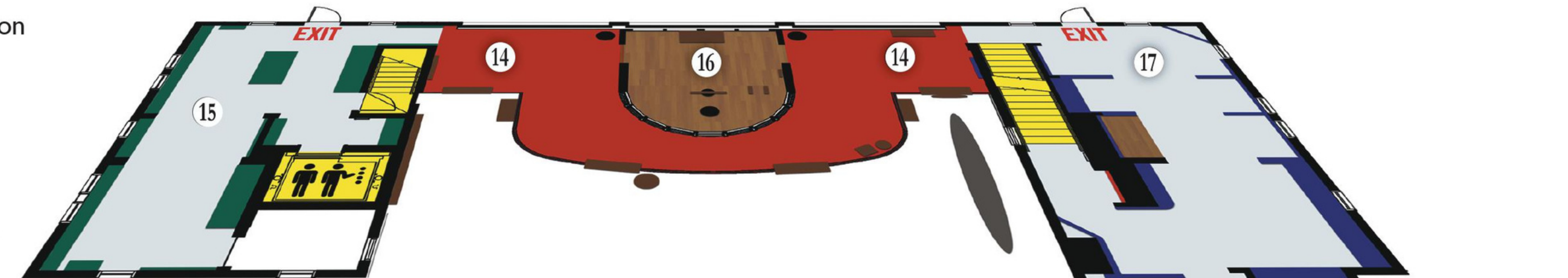

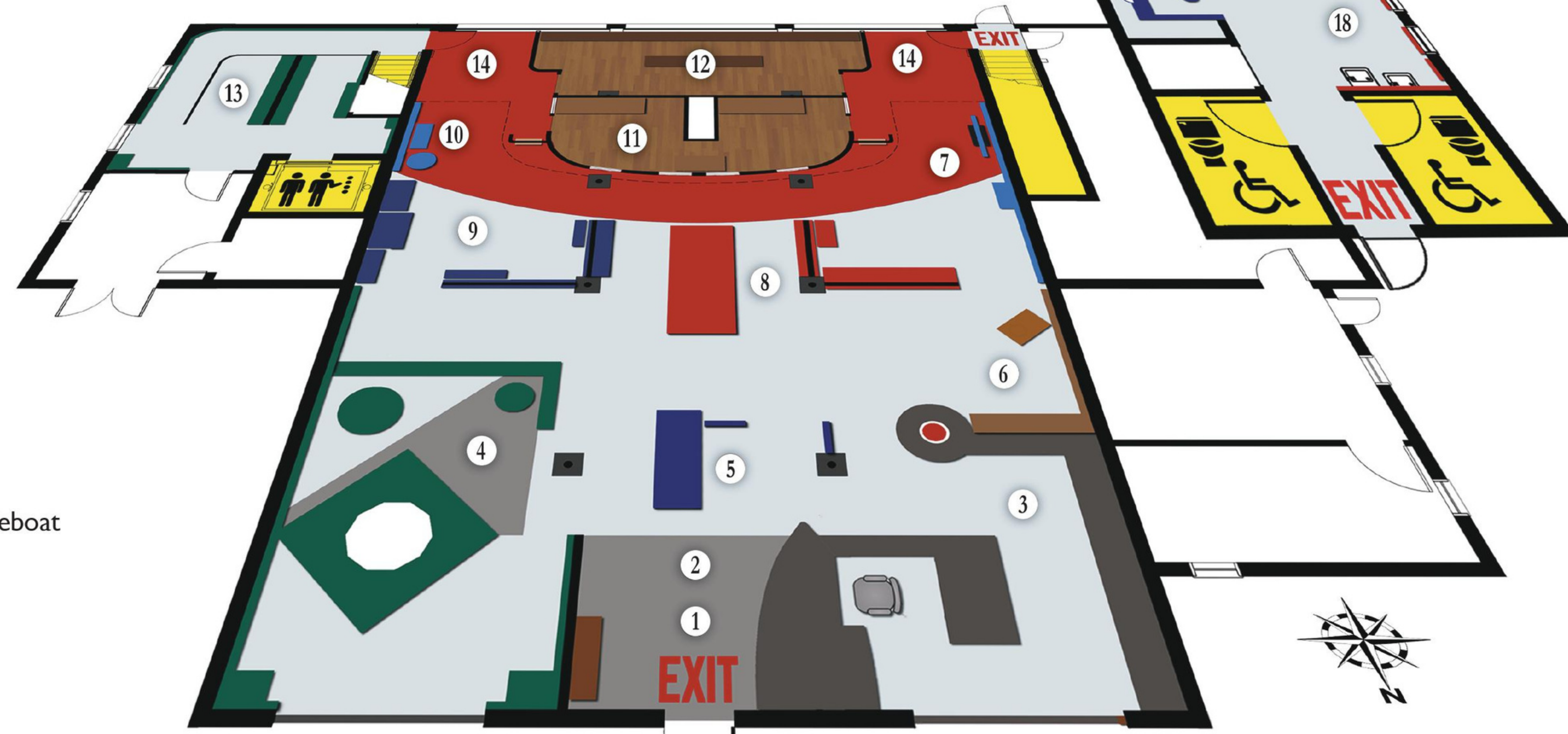
THREE FLOORS OF EXHIBITS in Ludington's 1934 Coast Guard Station
